



## **Boston Spa Sixth Form Dress Code**

In order to promote fairness, equality and give the sixth form a more adult image reflecting ours as a place of learning, the dress code is based on 'Business and Professional Dress'.

### **Boys**

Smart trousers

Smart Shirts or Polo shirts (with a collar)

Smart shoes

A cardigan or jumper may be worn

Ties and Jackets are optional

### **Girls**

Smart trousers, skirt or dress (no more than 4" above the knee)

Blouse, shirt or top (with appropriate neckline); no shoulders or midriffs should be visible.

Smart Shoes

A cardigan or jumper may be worn

In keeping with the dress code, students may not wear jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit bottoms, jeggings, 'just leggings', shorts, hoodies, flip-flops, trainers. Ugg (or similar style) boots. This list is not exhaustive and acts as a guideline.

There should be no extremes of fashion, no large or obvious logos. Hats and outdoor jackets/coats should be removed indoors as a matter of courtesy.

By following the dress code, we believe it strikes the right balance between some degree of individuality and setting an example to the rest of the school, parents, prospective employers and University admissions tutors and visitors to the school. We want to encourage smart dress that expresses our students' pride in their appearance.
