Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to inform you that the first phase of the planned £1 million renovation of the sixth form block will begin on Wednesday 29th May. There will be significant work done to remodel the social area, work area and upstairs classrooms, which we anticipate to be ready for the new school term in September. Whilst this is exciting news I am conscious to minimise any potential disruption to students during this crucial exam time.

The two key stages in this phase will involve the full closure of the following areas:


- Monday 3rd June: Social area including dining facilities and rooms 61-64, IT6 and IT7
- Monday 17th June: Work area including access to rooms 66-80

To minimise disruption the following changes will be made effective as of Monday 3rd June:

- The upper school diner will become a 6th form only dining space
- The Science area toilets will be for use exclusively by Year 12 and 13 students
- The library will replace the work area for independent study with timetabled lower school lessons moved elsewhere
- IT5 (next to the library) will be refitted with 20 PCs and opened exclusively for Year 12 and 13 students
- On return from study leave year 12 tutor rooms and lessons will be moved to suitable alternative venues.
